### AFFIDAVIT OF RESIDENCY

This Affidavit of Residency is to be used when the person seeking to enroll a student is living with a district resident. This form is used as evidence of residency when he or she cannot produce a lease, property ownership, or other similar document; in-district resident must prove residency with these documents – other documents will also be required to establish residency. The School District reserves the right to evaluate the evidence presented; completing this form does not guarantee admission.

Chicago Ridge School District 127.5 requires that all students attending 127.5 schools be bona fide residents of the District. To be a bona fide resident, a student must be living with a parent or guardian who is a resident of the district. At the time a student is registered, parents/guardians will be required to provide proof of residency. It's a Class C misdemeanor, punishable by a \$500 fine or up to 30 days in jail, to knowingly enroll a child in the wrong school district. Registration of a student who is not a resident is a fraudulent act. Any student found to have been fraudulently registered will be disenrolled from the district immediately. The Board of Education will take legal action against those registrants who fraudulently enroll in District 127.5. A prorated tuition fee will also be charged for the time the student was fraudulently enrolled.

**Important Warning:** If a student is determined to be a nonresident of the District for whom tuition must be charged, the persons enrolling the student are liable for non-resident tuition from the date the student began attending a District school as a non-resident.

A person who knowingly enrolls or attempts to enroll in this School District on a tuition-free basis a student known by that person to be a nonresident of the District is guilty of a Class C misdemeanor, except in very limited situations as defined in State law (105 ILCS 5/14-1.11).

A person who knowingly or willfully presents to the School District any false information regarding a student's residency to enable that student to attend any school in the District without the payment of a nonresident tuition charge is guilty of a Class C misdemeanor (105 ILCS 5/10-20.12b(2)).
